NEW PROGRAMMING HIGHLIGHTS

Medical Musings with Dr. JoAnn airs on the first Monday of the month at 8AM, starting February 5. A retired pediatrician and longtime spokesperson for the American Academy of Pediatrics, this show will feature health news from our area and around the world; interviews with local medical professionals; and a monthly focus on a particular health subject.

The *Community Character Hour* airs on the fourth Monday of the month at 8AM, a monthly exploration of a particular element of our local environment, with a basis in historical research and true storytelling. Produced in cooperation with the Bonner County Historical Society and Museum and the City of Sandpoint's Department of Arts, Culture and Historical Preservation.

The Beast and the Priest airs live every Monday night at 9, right after *Inland Island*. British Heavy Metal comes roaring onto our airwaves with a focus on the music of Judas Priest and Iron Maiden. Hosted by Terry Nobody. We recommend this program be played at maximum volume.

Tributes now follows the Hump Day Cafe on Wednesday nights- a new show to our airwaves, part time resident Linda Marek has been recording this well-researched and wide-ranging music program for years on community radio in Arizona. Every week features a new subject, musical style, or other inspiration.

The Little Live Radio Hour returns for a third year on our airwaves, with new shows on the fourth Tuesday of the month at 8PM, March through October. A co-production with the Festival at Sandpoint.

The Radio Flyer has come in for a mellow landing on Sundays, airing from noon til 2 PM. A musical blend of Americana, Folk, Bluegrass and more, hand selected each week by your captain, Scott McLongstreet.
